There was a ten-year old boy in the villa of San Quirico near Assisi who was crippled from birth. He had fragile shin-bones, his feet were turned sideways and he walked so crookedly that as soon as he got up, he would fall right down again. His mother had consecrated him to St. Francis many times, but there had not been any improvement. Since she had heard that Blessed Clare shone because of her recent miracles, she brought the child to her sepulcher. Several days later, his shin-bones crackled and his limbs returned to their natural position. Thus, the blessing that St. Francis did not grant in spite of numerous prayers was granted instead by his disciple, Clare, through divine favor.
