Sisters and brothers in Jesus and Francis,

What's the solution to "head knowledge faith"?

In the Secular Franciscan Order there are three answers to this question - formation, formation, and formation. Once we have completed initial formation during the candidacy period and entered into the professed life formation remains one of the most important parts of our growth in Jesus Christ, his Mystical Body the Church, and our Franciscan vocation and fraternal life.

Each day we commit ourselves to read the Word, to study the Word, to meditate on the Word, and to confess the Word with the expectation that in the presence of God we will come to live the Word and to become more and more like the Word. However, it takes time, patience, and work to come to believe what God says in the face of everyday obstacles and the ugliness of so much of the world today. This is why it is so very important to make sure, as our Seraphic Father Francis did, that the Word goes from the mental realm to the depths of our hearts.

As a matter of fact, we know that the difference between victory and defeat in the Catholic Christian life is the eighteen inches between our head and our heart. Ask yourself, do I just mentally agree with the Word, or is the Word planted in my heart? The answer to that question determines whether or not the Word will work for you.

As long as we live in this world, problems are going to come regardless of our Franciscan maturity. That's all the more reason to do what God said: "Go to the Word." Grasp it, believe it, and then watch the Word go into action. God watches over His Word to perform it! (Jer. 1:12.)

Saint Francis of Assisi was "the real deal," and then and now his integrity attracts followers to the Lord. People who came in contact with Francis found personal strengths they had not sufficiently appreciated. How can we become humble, "real deals"? Our way - ever constant formation within ourselves and within our fraternity under the guidance of the Word made flesh who dwells among us.

Let us pray. Lord God, I renew my mind with the Your Word and think Your thoughts guided by the Holy Spirit. Your Word is planted and rooted deep inside my heart. No matter what obstacles I face, I believe Your Word is living and true, and He whom You sent changes my life. Amen.


