Thursday, October 10, 2019

The pilgrimage will begin with departure from Washington Reagan National (DCA) (or your gateway city) on overnight flight to Rome Fiumicino airport (FCO, aka Leonardo da Vinci). Dinner and breakfast served on board.

Friday, October 11

After landing, we will meet your guide in the Rome airport. Then we will offer a private chartered coach to your Franciscan hotel in Assisi. Upon arrival in Assisi, we will begin exploring the life of St. Francis with a visit of St. Mary of the Angels Basilica. After some rest time, we will have our first time together for prayer and introduction to Assisi. Dinner and overnight in Assisi hotel.

Saturday, October 12

This morning we will continue our pilgrimage in the footsteps of Saint Francis with Mass and a guided visit of the world renowned Sacro Convento Basilica of St. Francis, where St. Francis' body is entombed. The church is adorned with beautiful frescoes painted by masters of the high Middle Ages like Giotto and Cimabue. After lunch in a nice restaurant in Assisi, we will take a walking tour through the Franciscan sites in the medieval part of Assisi including Chiesa Nuova, home of Bernard of Quintavalle, Saint Mary Major, and the Basilica of St. Clare. Overnight in Assisi hotel.

Sunday, October 13

Today we'll visit Rivotorto, where Francis and the first brothers lived in huts while they served lepers. Then we'll continue our journey eastbound through the Apennine Mountains to the little-known region of the Marches of Ancona. We will stop in Camerino to discover the origins of the Capuchin Franciscan Order and have lunch served by the friars. Then we will continue to Loreto, the city famed for the Holy House of Mary. We will return to Assisi for overnight.

Monday, October 14

After a guided visit through San Damiano in the morning, we will be free for the day in Assisi. Return to the hotel for meeting and prayer before dinner and overnight in the hotel.

Tuesday, October 15

Today we will journey to the mountain hermitage of Laverna in Tuscany where we will have a day of prayer and retreat. Time permitting, we will stop in Gubbio, where St. Francis tamed a wild wolf. Then we will continue to Laverna where, in 1224, St. Francis mysteriously received the stigmata, the wounds of Christ. We will accompany the friars on their daily procession at 3:00 and then return to Assisi for dinner and overnight

Wednesday, October 16

Today will be a free day at your leisure in Assisi for reflection or to do as you wish. Dinner and overnight in Assisi.

Thursday, October 17

This morning, we will depart for Rome. Along the way, we will stop in Greccio in the Rieti Valley, site where St. Francis initiated the first nativity scene. After lunch in a nice restaurant overlooking the Rieti valley, we will continue to Rome. After check-in at our Franciscan hotel, we will walk down to the Vatican for a casual visit.

Friday, October 18

Today, we will get to know Christian Rome with visits to Saint John Lateran (the cathedral of Rome), the Scala Santa (holy stairs believed to have been the steps on which Jesus was judged by Pontius Pilate), and Holy Cross (Santa Croce). After a bus tour of the ancient part of Rome, we will have lunch on our own, and then visit the Basilica of Saint Paul outside the Walls (where St. Paul was buried). Finally, we will visit the historic Catacombs of St. Callixtus, the official Christian cemetery during the persecutions and martyrdoms of early Christians. Dinner in a nice restaurant near St. Peter's, overnight in Rome hotel.

Saturday, October 19

Early morning chartered bus to Rome airport for return flight home.

PILGRIMAGE TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Nature of Pilgrimage and Accommodations: St. Francis Pilgrimages, LLC organizes religious travel itineraries in the Catholic pilgrimage tradition, rather than typical tours. As such, there is time set aside for private prayer and spiritual teaching. Accommodations are based on double occupancy and utilize superior class hotels, or religious hotels of good quality. All rooms have private bath. Given the religious nature of the pilgrimage, and that groups often overnight in religious hotels, participants are asked to adhere to the expectations as such.

Price: The published price per person includes R/T airfare from IAD, ground transportation as per itinerary in chartered coach, lodging (at double-occupancy), daily continental breakfast, and daily dinner (*beverages usually not included*). The price does not include one meal per day, tips (estimate \$10/day), recommended travel insurance, personal expenses, or anything not expressly stated on the itinerary. Payment can be made through Paypal for an additional 3% surcharge.

Payment Information: A deposit of \$500 is required to secure a reservation (\$200 is non-refundable but transferrable). Payments are due as follows: \$1500 is due 100 days prior to departure, and the remaining amount is due 70 days prior to departure. Trip prices and costs are listed in US dollars (usd). Cancellations: If you cancel more than 100 days before departure, all payments will be refunded except \$200 of your deposit (which is transferrable to another pilgrimage). If the cancellation is made between 100 days and 70 days of departure, the entire \$500 deposit amount is non-refundable. If you cancel within 70 days of departure, we will attempt to recover what has been paid to suppliers, but cannot guarantee any reimbursements. Once issued, airline tickets are usually non-refundable, and refunds would be determined by the specific airline. The pilgrimage price is based on a minimum of ten participants; with fewer, the overall price may be adjusted accordingly. Note that St. Francis Pilgrimages will only cancel a pilgrimage if there are insufficient registrations; if a pilgrimage is cancelled by St. Francis Pilgrimages, all payments will be refunded. However, if a participant cancels individually before St. Francis Pilgrimages officially cancels, refunds for that person will be based on the above criteria. We strongly recommend trip insurance.

Health: Participants often comment that the pilgrimage is strenuous, as it involves a lot of walking and stair climbing. If a participant has any health conditions (including psychological/mental), full disclosure to St. Francis Pilgrimages, LLC is required. Any participant who has serious health conditions must then inform his/her doctor of their intention to participate in the pilgrimage and submit a letter from his/her medical doctor stating that he/she is capable of fully participating in the pilgrimage without assistance. If such health conditions require extra assistance, such participant must be accompanied by an assistant. St. Francis Pilgrimages, LLC cannot accept liability for food ingested by participants with life-threatening food allergies or sensitivities. St. Francis Pilgrimages, LLC and suppliers contracted for services reserve the right to refuse to accept or retain any person whose behavior or health conditions are deemed likely to affect the smooth operations of the tour, or adversely affect the enjoyment or safety of other passengers.
