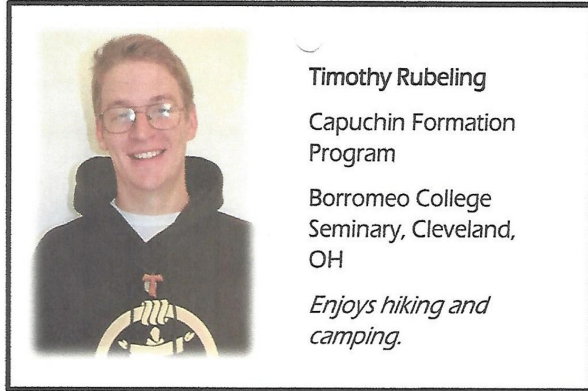

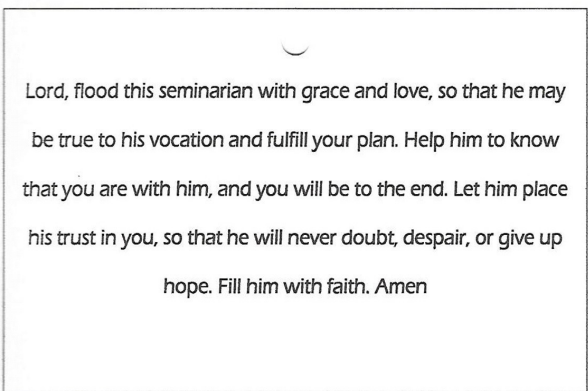
What is Spirituality?
