Maximillian Kolbe was a missionary to Japan arriving in that country August 1930. His health suffered a great deal during his time in Japan due to the climate, food and living conditions. Within a short time after his arrival he published his magazine, the Knight, in Japanese. It became the largest Catholic publication in Japan. Many were converted to the Catholic Faith.
