MINISTER'S MESSAGE

Brothers and Sisters of Penance,

Everyone recalls that this was our original name when we were formed by St. Francis, and we are called to penance, whether sacramental or in daily devotions. In the uneasiness of the world sometimes we can be wrapped up in events that draw our focus away from the virtues of charity and penance. From the Catechism of the Catholic Church on penance: "Scripture and the Fathers insist on all three forms fasting, prayer, and almsgiving." The first two are easily understood, but almsgiving is more than it appears at first glance. Consider: to give alms is to give of one's self, often more welcome than money. A smile, a kind word, reassuring someone who is anxious; the opportunities to share are many. We are joyful and for good reason, so share the joy! Also keep in mind that offering penance for others is virtuous and great charity. Finally, as a Fraternity, we should be in touch with our Sisters and Brothers, "Just thought I'd check to see how you're doing" is a good start, whether by phone, email, or text. Seeing each other once a month is pleasant, but hurried conversations over lunch is not enough. Jesus wrote His love song on our hearts, we need to sing it.

Our brother Frank Rega shares the following:

From "A Letter to the Entire Order" by St. Francis.

In the name of the most high Trinity and holy Unity: the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit.

To all my reverend and dearly beloved brothers: to Brother A., the General Minister of the Order of Friars Minor, its lord, and the other general ministers who will come after him, and to the ministers, custodians, humble priests of this same brotherhood in Christ, and to all simple and obedient brothers, from the first to the last: Brother Francis, a worthless and weak man, your very little servant sends his greetings in Him Who has redeemed and washed us in His most precious blood. When you hear His name, the name of that Son of the Most High, our Lord Jesus Christ, Who is blessed forever, adore His name with fear and reverence, prostrate on the ground!

Listen, sons of the Lord and my brothers, pay attention to my words. Incline the ear of your heart and obey the voice of the Son of God. Observe His commands with your whole heart and fulfill His counsels with a perfect mind. Give praise to Him because He is good; exalt Him by your deeds; for

this reason He has sent you into the whole world: that you may bear witness to His voice in word and deed and bring everyone to know that there is no one who is all-powerful except Him. Persevere in discipline and holy obedience and, with a good and firm purpose, fulfill what you have promised Him. The Lord God offers Himself to us as to His children.

Kissing your feet, therefore, and with all that love of which I am capable, I implore all of you brothers to show all possible reverence and honor to the most holy Body and Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ in Whom that which is in heaven and on earth has been brought to peace and reconciled to almighty God.

Let everyone be struck with fear, let the whole world tremble, and let the heavens exult when Christ, the Son of the living God, is present on the altar in the hands of a priest! O wonderful loftiness and stupendous dignity! O sublime humility! O humble sublimity! The Lord of the universe, God and the Son of God. so humbles Himself that for our salvation He hides Himself under an ordinary piece of bread! Brothers, look at the humility of God, and pour out your hearts before Him! **Humble yourselves** that you may be exalted by Him! Hold back nothing of yourselves for yourselves,

that He Who gives Himself totally to you

may receive you totally!
