From the Minister's Desk

Facebook is an excellent way to stay in touch with family, friends, and organizations to which we belong, a way to share thoughts, pictures, and information. At the same time because it is an almost immediate tool of communication it can bring messages that cause emotional pain and anger into our lives.

On Sunday, January 23, I posted a comment on Facebook that was supportive of our good, holy priests while admitting there are bad priests that have brought scandal into the Church. Out of the blue, from a person I do not know who is a Facebook friend of one of my Facebook friends, came an attack on Holy Mother Church, all priests and on me personally for supporting priests. Outraged by the viciousness and obscenities used, my initial reaction was to respond intemperately. I wrote a reply with venom in my heart. Thankfully, impressed by Jesus, I decided to edit it and as I read it I realized I had fallen into a trap because I was responding with anger and irrational arguments not as Jesus would, not as Francis would. In short, I realized I was commenting in the same way she had.

At that point, nudged by the Holy Spirit, I recalled a proverb I had copied recently, ""Watch your tongue and keep your mouth shut, and you will stay out of trouble." (Proverbs 21:25 NLT.) I prayed a prayer I had written in response to reading that proverb. "Lord, teach me constantly when to speak and when to hold my tongue and help me to do it. Amen."

So, I deleted that response and copied the prayer for priests from St. Faustina's Diary into the comment box, commented peace and all good and hit send. I have yet to receive a response.

I learned four lessons from this experience: first, don't speak or write in anger. If your response is verbal pray a short prayer before responding if in writing read it over and ask the Lord if you should send it. Second, answer with prayer for the situation. Turn away from the negative, stay positive. Third, remain in the Lord and he will give you peace and then offer that peace to all others without exception. Finally, our Franciscan walk helps us deal with challenging situations with a peaceful heart and soul as we live Gospel values in our hearts and into the world. Peace and all good.
