Minister's Moment

Franciscan Stones

I imagine that our Seraphic father, Saint Francis must have been desperate for an answer when he entered San Damiano. I can see the dimly lit sanctuary with the smell of ancient incense hanging in the air. There may have been a flicker of candlelight dancing on the walls as Saint Francis fell to his knees in front of the altar and crucifix. There in that church he sought the answer to an age-old question, "What am I to do with my life?" At the feet of Jesus, he received his answer: *"Francis, go and repair my church which, as you see, is all in ruins!*"

I know that there are times that I feel a despair of what to do with my life as I sit in front of the Blessed Sacrament. I open my Bible and read a Psalm or a letter from St Paul. I look for a word or verse to inspire me, something that will speak to my heart and soothe me. *Just say the word and my soul shall be healed*. Recently, I reflected on my life being pretty busy – is it too much sometimes? There are plenty of days when I have little to do, and I have time to regenerate. Time and time again, I am called to rebuild the church – one stone at a time: one student at a time; one scout at a time; one doctor's appointment at a time; one hospital visit at a time.

Don't be fooled. Unlike Saint Francis, there are plenty of moments where I avoid kissing the leper. There are plenty of times that I am not generous or kind or patient. Each of us has different gifts, and God calls us to rebuild the church with those gifts. Think about what talent God has graced you with and how you are sharing that gift. Think about those moments that you are emptying yourself so that others can be filled. Think about how you are rebuilding the church. Then, be like Francis and put another stone in the church walls, and know that you are where you are supposed to be.

The Rule Review

26. As a concrete sign of communion and co-responsibility, the councils on various levels, in keeping with the constitutions, shall ask for suitable and well-prepared religious for spiritual assistance. They should make this request to the superiors of the four religious Franciscan families, to whom the Secular Fraternity has been united for centuries. To promote fidelity to the charism as well as observance of the Rule and to receive greater support in the life of the fraternity, the minister or president, with the consent of the council, should take care to ask for a regular pastoral visit by the competent religious superiors as well as for a fraternal visit from those of the higher fraternities, according to the norm of the Constitutions.^{*}
