Happy Advent! Happy Church New Year, Merry Christmas 💩 , Happy Secular New Year 🚱 ,

We are now a full week into Advent 2023. Yes, that is correct in the Church's reckoning of time we are in 2023 - the Liturgical Year A. I pray with hope and joy that whatever prayer plan you are following in Advent 2023 is bearing much spiritual meat for your soul's preparation to receive Blessed Jesus into your soul on Christmas & .

And toot sweet, Advent is followed by the Great Octave of Christmas, 8 days beginning on Christmas Day, which are so filled with meaning for our faith growth that Mother Church celebrates it as ONE day. During the season of Christmas we celebrate Mary, the Mother of Jesus, the Holy Family of Nazareth, various martyred saints, Sts. Stephen, Thomas a Becket and the Holy Innocents of Bethlehem, and John the Evangelist.

This year we get to celebrate within the Christmas season two memorials of USA saints with local importance St. Elizabeth Ann Seton, the first Saint of the USA canonized by Mother Church who was a mother, caregiver, foundress, and educator, and St. John Neumann, who was stationed in ADB for a time, and later the Archbishop of Philadelphia, PA.

Then comes, drum roll please, our great feast of the Epiphany in which we celebrate the manifestation of Jesus as Savior and Lord to us, the Gentiles, the barbarians, those whom ancient Israel often believed were unforgivable sinners and not saved. Boy, did God teach them a lesson. And we close out celebrating the Christmas mysteries on the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

Quite the celebration isn't it. Many in the secular world have pretty much given up the celebration on December the 26th. The rest on January the 1st. But we Catholics keep it going to the Baptism of the Lord and, if you like all the traditional feasts, don't forget February 2 the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord in the Temple 😭.

So have yourself a Happy Advent, New Year and a Joy filled Christmas this year.

Let us pray: Lord Jesus come and be born in our hearts that this Advent-Christmas season will be our best ever. Amen.


PERFECT JOY! In Rejection Celebrating the Joy of Jesus in the Season of Lent Presenters Needed!
