What is a Chapter of Mats?

Our Father Francis knew it was important for his brothers to gather at intervals to listen to one another and renew their enthusiasm and commitment to spreading the gospel and rebuilding the Church. In 1221, St. Francis called his brothers to a general chapter. The number of brothers had grown so large that they had to bring mats to sleep on. Some say 5,000, and some say 3,000 friars assembled and lived in huts or tents made of these reed mats. It was a joyful reunion and an opportunity to share their experiences on the road. Francis himself called this gathering a Chapter of Mats.

The name has great significance for us. It was the first time St. Francis assembled all his brothers from Italy and beyond to gather as one body. And for us, it is a time to assemble all Secular Franciscans from all fraternities within St. Margaret of Cortona Region to share and seek the Holy Spirit's guidance for the path we are to take in the coming years.

Housing Options:

The Commuter Option is now available. The cost is \$150 and includes all meals, liturgies, and group sessions for all three days. Please consider requesting financial assistance for overnight housing if you are choosing this option due to cost.

Event Costs:

All meals (Friday dinner through Sunday breakfast) and registration fees are included in the cost of the rooms and the commuter fee.

The lodging cost is based on the type of housing selected from the options below. There are no additional fees.

- Inn double room/2 queen beds for 2 persons (\$275 per person) roommate may be designated or assigned
- Inn double room/2 queen beds for three persons (\$230 per person) must designate roommates
- Inn double room/2 queen beds for four persons (\$210 per person) must designate roommates
- Cottage two twin beds per room for 2 persons (\$235 per person) roommate may be designated or assigned (no single rooms in cottages)
- Commuter fee meals, liturgies, and group sessions for all three days (\$150 per person)
