MINISTER'S NOTE

Our Rule states that “The local fraternity is to be established canonically. It becomes the basic unit of the whole Order and a visible sign of the Church, the community of love.” (Rule, Article 22)

We are the community of love. Nothing is greater than this– to love one another. It is a gift for us to come together each month. It is a gift for us to be able to be present for our brothers and sisters.

On his deathbed, Saint Francis did not say that he founded an order or gathered followers. Instead, he spoke in gratitude and humility:

“The Lord gave me brothers.”

That single line says everything about Franciscan love.

Saint Francis understood his life as a gift received. He did not have disciples, but brothers that God entrusted to him. He then challenged the brothers to do what Christ intended: to love and serve.

This year as you take your saint and prayer partner for the year, think about all the ways that you can be present for them over the coming months.

Our Franciscan brothers and sisters are our family. It is important that we care for one another. This is a sacred obligation.

In *Fratelli Tutti*, Pope Francis wrote: “Here we have a splendid secret that shows us how to dream and to turn our life into a wonderful adventure. No one can face life in isolation... We need a community that supports and helps us, in which we can help one another to keep looking ahead. How important it is to dream together... ”. (*Fratelli Tutti*, paragraph 8)

Let our fraternity become a place where care abounds. Let us support each other in life’s adventures. Let us be a community of love.
